Private Boat Storage

Private boat storage is now at a premium. The Barwon Rowing Club needs to objectively determine which members are permitted to store their private boats in the Shed.

Guidelines

1. Permission will be granted by the Captain and Vice Captain.
2. Permission is granted for a period of 12 months.
 - 2.1. The 12 month period will commence on the 1st of June and end on the 31st May the following year.
3. A racking fee will be applicable.
 - 3.1. Payable within 7 days of permission being granted.
 - 3.2. The racking fee will be determined by the General Committee and will be reviewed annually. Members will be notified of the racking fee in May for the following year.
4. Applications will be made using a completed form,
 - 4.1. To be submitted by the **ASAP**.
 - 4.2. Decisions on racking will be made from **TBA**.
5. Anyone storing private boats in the Clubhouse does so at their own risk. The Club will not be responsible for any vandalism, theft, fire, flood damage etc. to any private boats stored in the Clubhouse.
6. Barwon Rowing Club boats will have priority over any privately owned boats.
7. The applying member assures the Club they will make good on any future actions they have declared on the application.
 - 7.1. Applications will be reviewed if actions are reneged and permission can be revoked.
 - 7.2. Permission can only be revoked by the General Committee

Criteria

Criteria	Weighting
Current financial Full or Student member	Prerequisite
Consistently race and represent the Barwon Rowing Club throughout the season. Be raced at significant regattas in the season – Championships, elite program etc.	40%
Member assists the Club	30%
The boat is used consistently during the season	20%
Are other members permitted to use the boat	10%
TOTAL	100%
